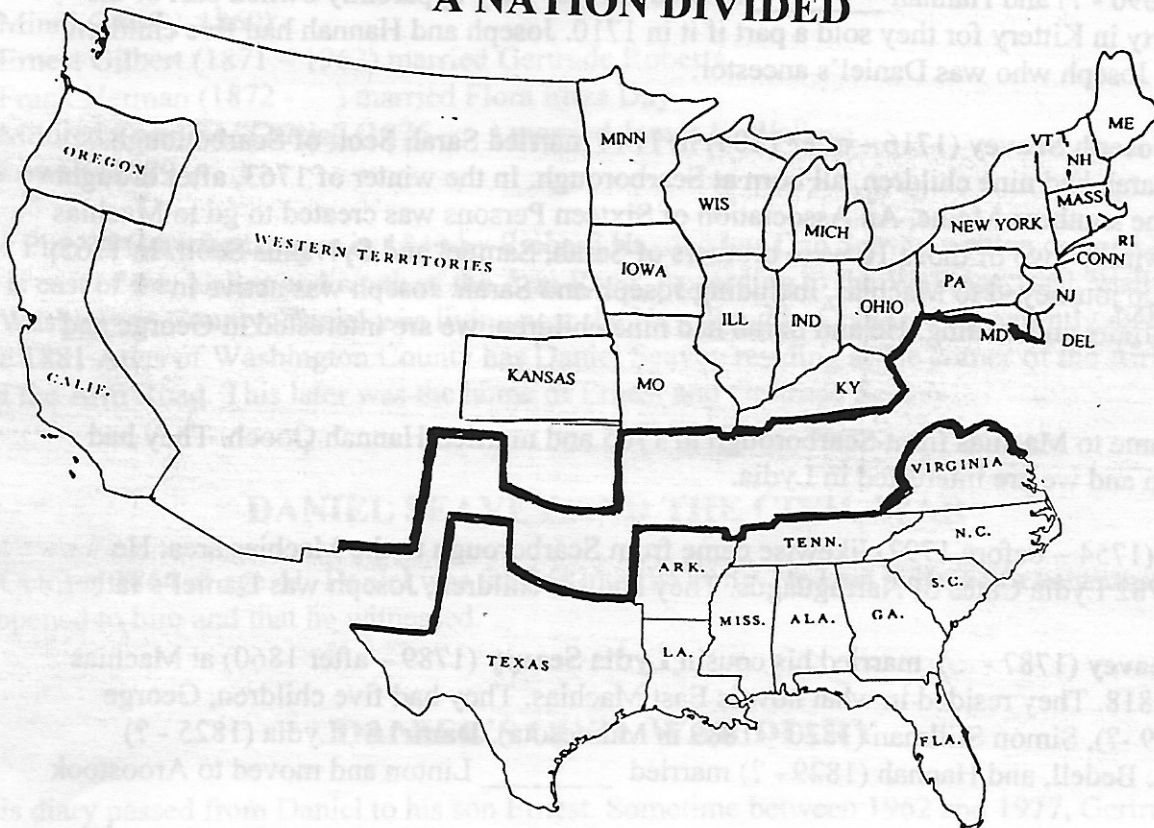

A NATION DIVIDED



Missouri, Kentucky, and Maryland were slave states that stayed within the Union.

West Virginia seceded from Virginia and became a state in 1863.

Nevada became a state in 1864.

On April 12, 1861, the first shots were fired at Fort Sumter in Charleston Harbor, South Carolina
On April 9, 1865, Lee surrendered to Grant at Appomattox Court House, Virginia.
