THE DESCENDANTS OF HER DAUGHTER: SUSAN BLACKINGTON KEENE

This article provides information on the descendants of Susan Blackington Keene. Susan was the second child of Mary Harrington Bailey and the first with the Keene name. It appears that her father was a trader from St. Stephen, New Brunswick who often visited John K. Damon's farm in Alexander. Susan had ten children during her 57 married years to Thomas Putman Bridges. All of the children and descendants are listed below.
