### **Assessors/Jane Manza**

- The update and maintenance to the Trio Program came in at a cost of \$ 9,000.00

### **Breakneck Mountain ATV Club -Chad Smith/Matt Prue**

- The Club would like to apply for a Municipal Grant and change the funds from going to the Town of Crawford to the Town of Alexander.
- The town's only responsibility would be to collect the funds and then allocate it back over to the Club through the town warrant system. All paperwork would be done by the Club.

### **Roads/Larry Hill**

- Salt costs for treatment of the winter roads came in at \$88.50 a ton, same as last year.
- Green Hill Road, only discussing caring for the Alexander Section. Road needs at least grading right now. Would like to hot top, 15 loads of gravel would be needed along with ditching and possible culverts. Would like to have David Lee ready it for hot top at his earliest convenience. How far should we go? Need an easement for a turn around.
