Town Clerk/Kristy Crawford

- Kristy discussed and asked for recommendations on how to pay and record the Fire Dept. Fit Test expenses for this year.
 - Motion was made by James Gibson Jr. to take it from and record it in the Administration account for this year, a 2nd by John Knowles. All in Favor.
- For insurance purposes the town needs to have a Cyber Assessment Policy to be compliant and to be covered.
 - James Gibson Jr. made a motion to write an acceptable Cyber Assessment Use Policy. 2nd by Foster Carlow Jr. All in Favor.
 - By consensus, James Gibson Jr. will contact Danny Sullivan for guidance and recommendations.

Roads/Larry Hill

- Larry has been in contact with County Concrete and Northeast Paving, for the paving of the Davis Road. Certified Paving did return his calls.
 - County Concrete quoted \$125 a ton for hot top, with no added cost of handwork. Northeast paving quoted \$132 a ton plus \$4,000 more for handwork. County Concrete, \$117,000, Northeast Paving, \$108,000.
 - By consensus the Road Commissioners/Selectmen gave Road Supervisor Larry Hill the authority to use County Concrete.
- New Road signs will be arriving and put up this week.

School/Ted Carter

- The school budget will increase by 2% for the upcoming school year.

Pokey Landing

- The rocks have been moved, (not removed).
- The No overnight parking sign is missing.
 - By consensus the selectmen decided the sign should be replaced and asked Larry Hill to take care of the matter.
