

**CULVERT ORDINANCE**

for the

**ALEXANDER, MAINE**

Section 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Ordinance is a preventative measure in order to keep road repair costs at a minimum and is supported by 23 MRSA §3253.

Section 2. Authority

This Ordinance has been prepared in accordance with 30-A MRSA §2101 - 2109.

Section 3. Effective date

This Ordinance, which was adopted by the municipal legislative body on June 15, 1992, shall become effective July 1, 1992.

Section 5. Maintenance

Maintenance of culverts; keeping them free of debris and in working order, shall be the responsibility of the landowner.

Section 6. Inspection

Prior to September 30<sup>th</sup> of each year, the Road Commissioner for the Town of Alexander shall inspect all culverts - cross road and private drive - and report to the Municipal Clerk the location of all culverts in need of repair or clean out.

Section 7. Enforcement

The Municipal Clerk shall notify owners of action needed; repair or (and) clean out. The owners shall have until October 31<sup>st</sup> to remedy the problem. If the problem is not remedied, the Road Commissioner will do so at the owners' expense.
