CULVERT ORDINANCE

for the

ALEXANDER, MAINE

Section 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Ordinance is a preventative measure in order to keep road repair costs at a minimum and is supported by 23 MRSA §3253.

Section 2. Authority

This Ordinance has been prepared in accordance with 30-A MRSA $\S 2101 - 2109$.

Section 3. Effective date

This Ordinance, which was adopted by the municipal legislative body on June 15, 1992, shall become effective July 1, 1992.

Section 5. Maintenance

Maintenance of culverts; keeping them free of debris and in working order, shall be the responsibility of the landowner.

Section 6. Inspection

Prior to September 30th of each year, the Road Commissioner for the Town of Alexander shall inspect all culverts - cross road and private drive - and report to the Municipal Clerk the location of all culverts in need of repair or clean out.

Section 7. Enforcement

The Muncipal Clerk shall notify owners of action needed; repair or (and) clean out. The owners shall have until October 31 to remedy the problem. If the problem is not remedied, the Road Commissioner will do so at the owners' expense.
